Length of Stay: 18 days



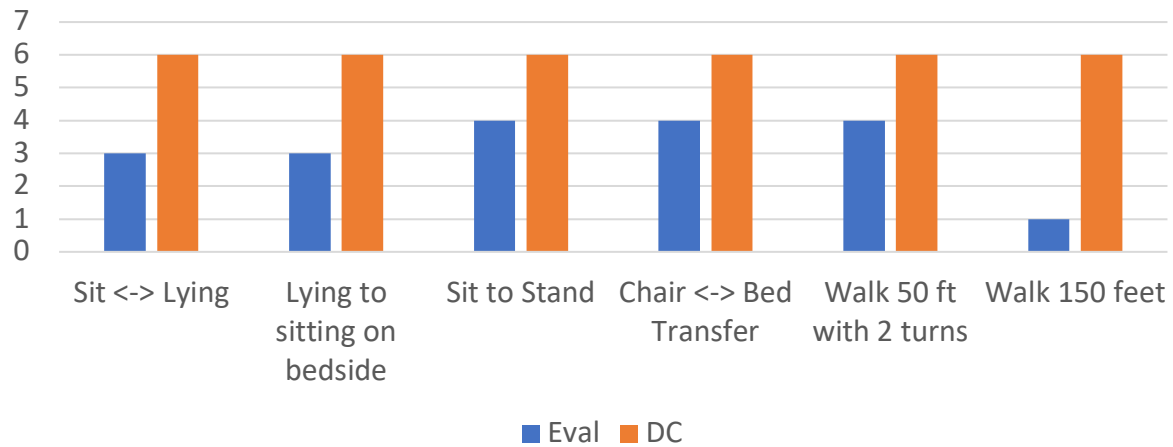
Background:

“Tennessee wait for me” is what Maxine uttered when we asked her “Maxine, what is your discharge plan?” Maxine stated that she will go home with Beth, her daughter that lives in Tennessee. Maxine stated that in Beth’s house she have 4 steps without hand rails and that she wanted to be walking before she discharges from Park manor Cypress Station. Her daughter Beth will fly over to Houston and pick her up to bring her to Tennessee. Maxine is an 87 year old female patient referred for therapy evaluation secondary to hospitalization on 7/29/24 after repeated falls due to impaired balance, and after having a left hip hemiarthroplasty on 7/29. Maxine was admitted to Park manor Cypress Station for further assessment and evaluation. On initial evaluation, Maxine presents with noted deficit in strength, balance and functional mobility. Maxine exhibits forward lean of trunk which are associated with the underlying causes of reduced functional activity tolerance and is at risk for falls.

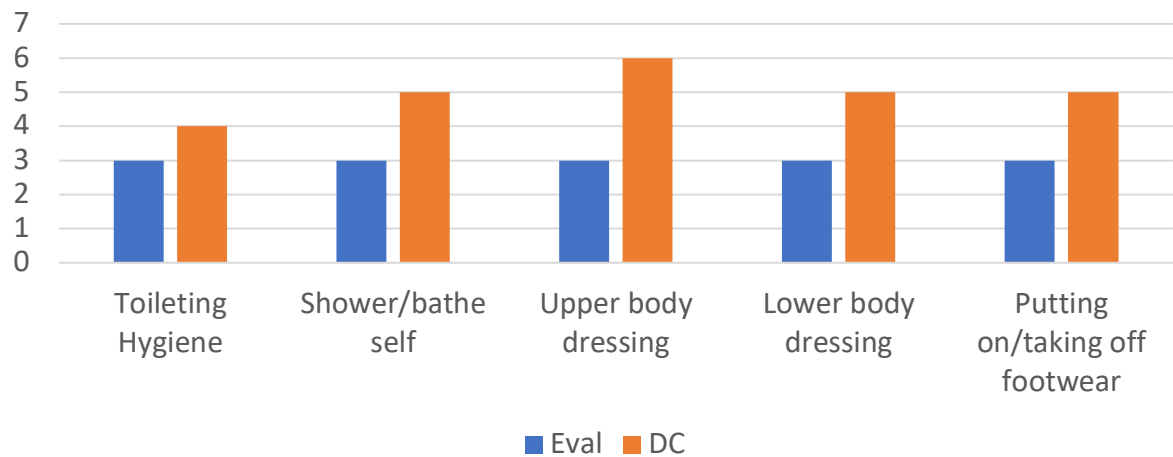
Outcomes:

Maxine has decided to live with h daughter Beth in Tennessee that she asked the Director of Rehabilitation to print her schedule and wants to know the time of her therapy so she will be ready. Maxine has a happy and positive demeanor. She is easy to work with and compliant to her lower leg precautions. She did excellent on her therapy that she reached all her goals. Maxine was able to walk 150FT using 2WW and did the stairs 5 times. Maxine is excited to fly to Tennessee. She discharged with her daughter Beth and is now in Tennessee.

06 - Independent

Completes the activity by him/herself with no assistance from a helper

05 - Setup or clean-up assistance

Helper sets up or cleans up; patient completes activity. Helper assists only prior to or following the activity.

04 - Supervision or touching assistance

Helper provides verbal cues and/or touching/steadying and/or contact guard assistance as patient completes activity. Assistance may be provided throughout the activity or intermittently.

03 - Partial/moderate assistance

Helper does LESS THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts, holds, or supports trunk or limbs, but provides less than half the effort.

02 - Substantial/maximal assistance

Helper does MORE THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts or holds trunk or limbs and provides more than half the effort.

01 - Dependent

Helper does ALL of the effort. Patient does none of the effort to complete the activity. Or the assistance of 2 or more helpers is required for the patient to complete the activity.
